# **Summary Revelation**

- Theme: True discipleship means self-denial, suffering, and surrender.

"Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it."

- Theme: Life's paradox—gain comes through loss; self-denial leads to true life.

- Theme: Receiving Christ's messengers equals receiving Christ Himself.
